## The Preacher's Post – Darin Kennedy

In Acts 17, Paul speaks before the Areopagus in Athens. He testifies to his faith in God before great philosophers, unintimidated by their credentials. Paul himself is well-trained in Greek philosophy, culture, and literature and can communicate in the language and ideas of the empire. In this speech, we have the only recorded speech given to complete unbelievers, those who are ignorant of the one, true God, and Paul testifies of the truth that violates the wisdom of any culture, that someone was raised from the dead.

As school begins, we remember that it is important for our children to learn to speak the language of the world so that they might also communicate the truth that changes the world. They learn logical reasoning through math, the heartfelt language of literature, clear communication through writing, the marvels of the created world in science, and the story of the rise and fall of kingdoms in history. They need to know that the knowledge they are gaining is not for the acquiring of a diploma, but for the training of a messenger of God. In addition to their classes, they are learning how to live life in and to interact with an unbelieving world. They will learn to mourn for such a world, but they will also learn to love the people in that world.

Being a disciple of Jesus does not lessen the importance of worldly education; instead, it increases the importance when it is captured up in the work of the kingdom of God. In the same way, your secular work, as well as your child's future occupation, is not an interruption or a violation of kingdom work; instead, it also is captured up into opportunities for the expansion of the kingdom. Paul shows in Athens that the other-worldly nature of the gospel invades the established rhetoric of this world in the same way Jesus, the eternal Word, invaded flesh and blood and "lived among us."

You have been well-equipped to be a powerful messenger of God by Bible class teachers and preachers, alongside Mrs. Henderson in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, Mr. Clark in the school chorus, Mr. Calvin in speech and debate, Mr. Brown in algebra, Mrs. Williams in senior English, and Dr. Stephens in World History. At least, those are the ones who trained me; you know those who trained you.
